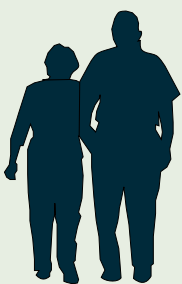


# Celebrating 50 Years of the Older Americans Act Nutrition Program



## NEVADA BENEFITS

For 50 years, the Older Americans Act (OAA) Nutrition Program has ensured older adults have affordable and nutritious meals. The program promotes socialization and reduces food insecurity.



### In Nevada:

- Nearly 30,100 older adults receive meals.<sup>1</sup>
- An estimated 2.5 million meals are served each year.<sup>2</sup>



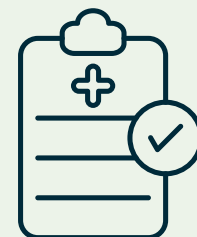
The OAA Nutrition Program is available to nearly 656,500 people ages 60+ in Nevada.<sup>3</sup>

An estimated 6.2 percent of older adults in Nevada are food insecure.<sup>4</sup>



Nevada receives over \$4.7 million<sup>5</sup> to provide services through 53 local programs.<sup>6</sup>

Nationally, the vast majority of participants say the program improves their health and independence.<sup>7</sup>
